## **GENERAL NORMS FOR MEMBERS**

- 1 Entry into the Swimming Pool Complex will be allowed only with the Membership Card
- 2 While entering the Complex, the member must enter his/her name and membership number in the register meant for the purpose at the reception
- 3 The Complex Staff are authorized to demand the Membership Card for verification at any point of time
- 4 Proper swimming costume is a must for users
- 5 Smoking/consuption of alcohol is strictly prohibited inside the complex
- 6 The Management will not be responsible for any loss of personal belongings in any case
- 7 Membership renewal will be done within 3 days of expiry. Any further delay shall lead to an automatic cancellation of membership
- 8 No refund or partly refund will be made once membership has been obtained
- 9 No adjustment of the days of absence shall be made under any circumstances
- 10 Entry to the main pool will be allowed only when one knows how to swim and his/her expertise has been approved by the trainer
- 11 The academy will not be responsible for any mishap in any case
- 12 Personal / private trainers will not be allowed entry into the complex
- 13 Code of conduct as laid down by the Swimming Pool Complex Management will have to be followed in letter and in spirit
- 14 Girls will wear one-piece swimsuits, which must be non-transparent. Swimming caps are compulsory for all trainees with long hair. Red caps are compulsory for beginners.
- 15 Children suffering from cough, cold, viral or any sort of skin disease will not be allowed to enter the pool
- 16 Members must report 15 minutes before the scheduled time at the reception of the Swimming Pool Complex
- 17 Swimmers will bring their own Swimming Kit
- 18 The pool is for only swimming. Any mischief/ prank played in or around the pool should be avoided. It may not only disturb others but also jeopardize one's right of entry into the complex
- 19 Principal's decision shall be final and irrevocable in case of any dispute
- 20 The membership card will be issued only after deposition fee. If the card is lost, a new one can be obtained after paying Rs 50/-
- 21 Any case of dispute, if arises, shall be filed within the jurisdiction territory of Sonepat only

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR SWIMMERS**

- 1 Do not apply lotion/cream on the body before entering the pool
- 2 Take shower before and after a swim
- 3 Please use the foot mat placed on the deck area before entering the pool
- 4 In case you have long hair, do wear a swimming cap
- 5 Do not take pets inside the complex
- 6 Don't take any food item inside the pool arena
- 7 In case you are a beginner, wear a red cap so that lifeguards & trainers may identify you
- 8 Use pool ladder to enter or exit the pool to avoid any injury
- 9 Don't take heavy meals before a swim
- 10 Do not attempt "hear first" dive unless you are being supervised by your coach
- 11 Abstain from entering the pool if you have ailments like asthma, epilepsy, cardiac complications, etc.
