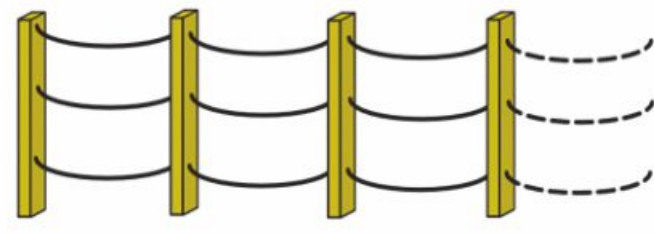

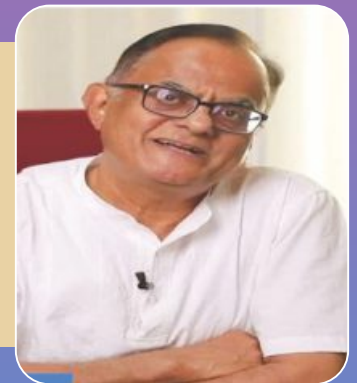


Bery – New Vice-chairperson of NITI Aayog

India's New Chief of Army Staff

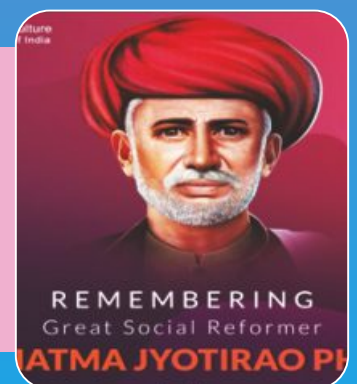
