Baisakhi has arrived in all its majesty.*

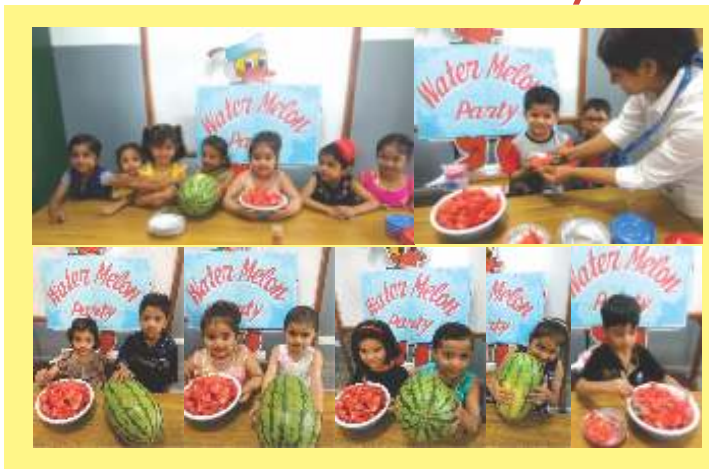
