Students' Diary Checking

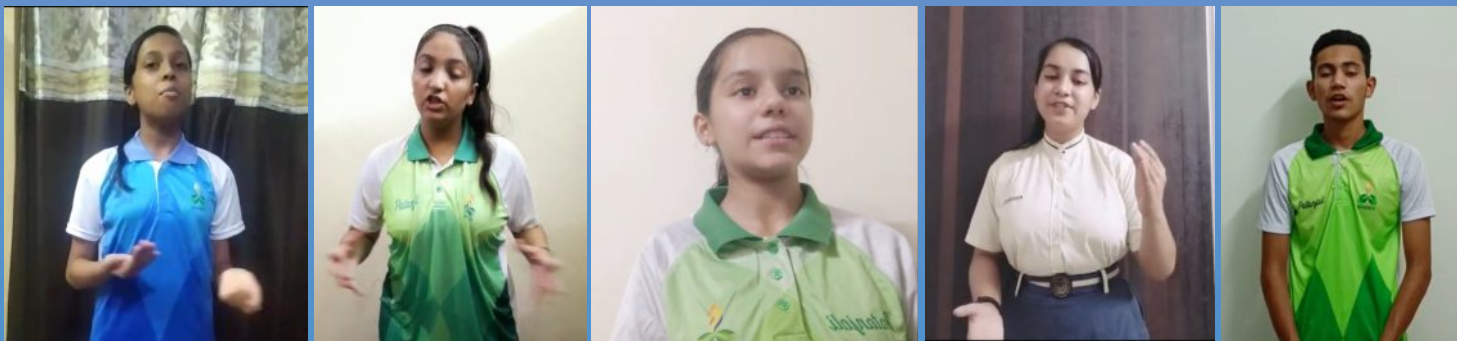
27 March 2021

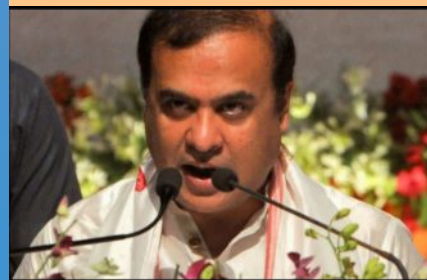
Sushil Chandra was appointed as the Chief Election Commissioner and he assumed the charge on 13 April 2021.

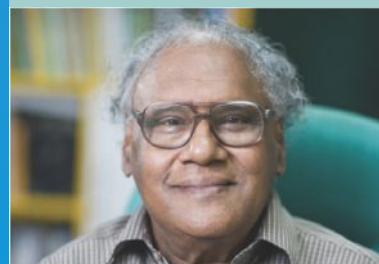
