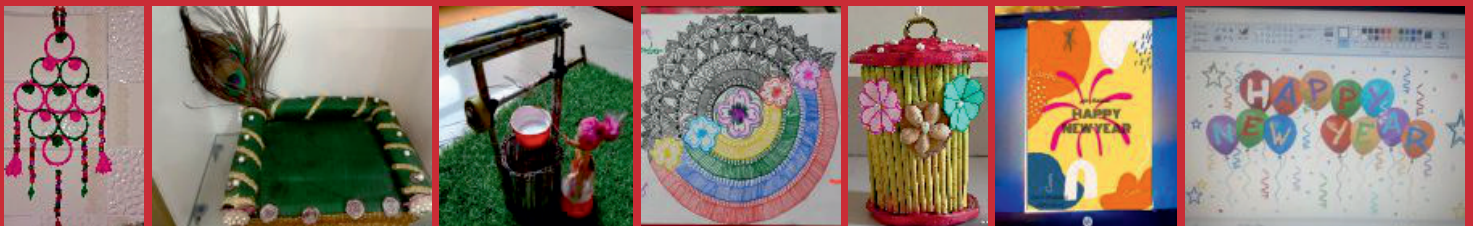


# Various Government Quizzes and Competitions

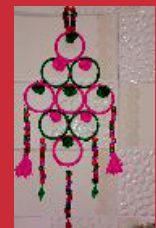
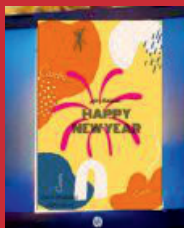


# CBSE Science Challenge

12 January 2022

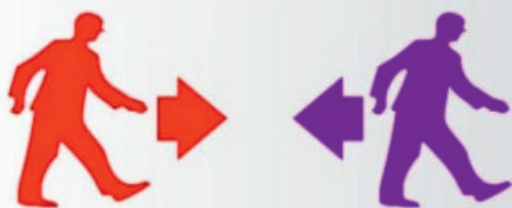

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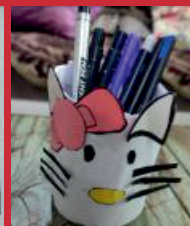
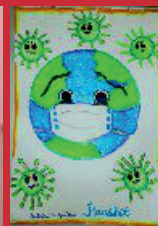

## Fatima Sheikh: India's first Muslim Woman Teacher

On 9th January 2022, Google celebrated birth anniversary of famous educator and feminist icon Fatima Sheikh, who is widely considered to be India's first Muslim woman teacher, with a doodle. Sheikh, with social reformers Jyotirao and Savitribai Phule, co-founded the Indigenous Library in 1848, one of India's first schools for girls. She met great resistance from the dominant classes who attempted to humiliate those involved in the Satyashodhak movement.

Nobel Peace Laureate Kailash Satyarthi has been appointed by UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres as a Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Advocate.
