


International Youth Talk


01 December 2021



You can try to solve these puzzles just by looking, but it's more fun to grab some pencils and coins and get playing!


In touch

How can you arrange these six pencils so that each one touches all of the other five?




Fun house

Can you move two pencils to create 11 squares?





Take two
