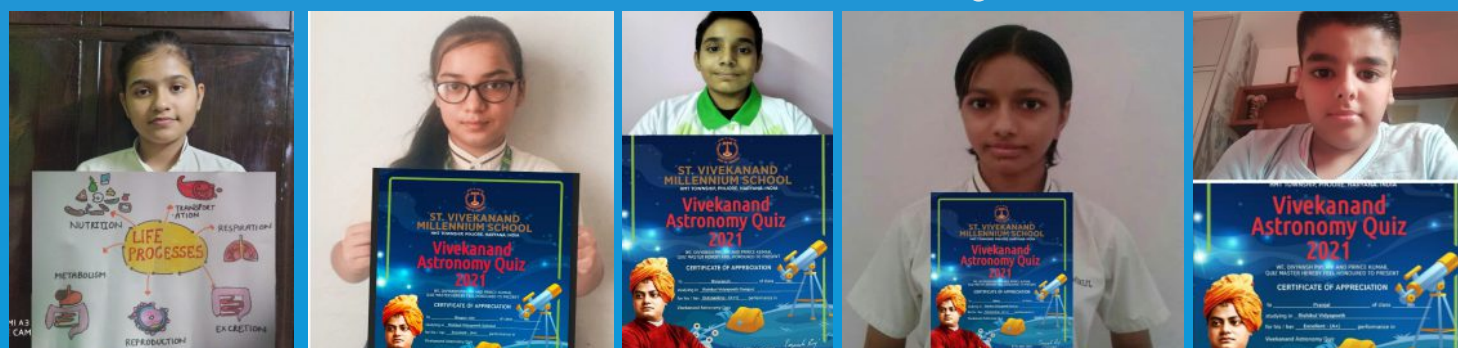

Ganga Quest

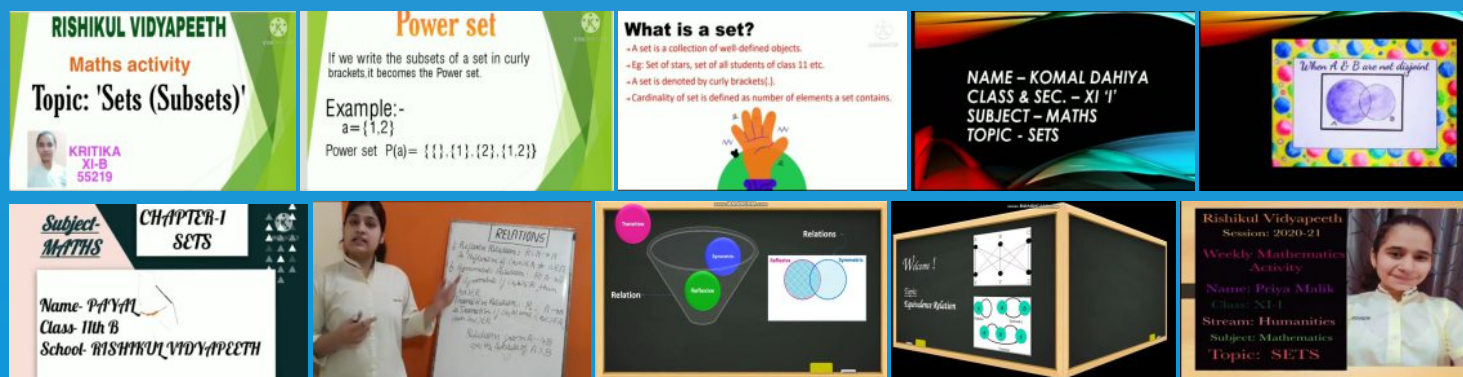
30 May 2021

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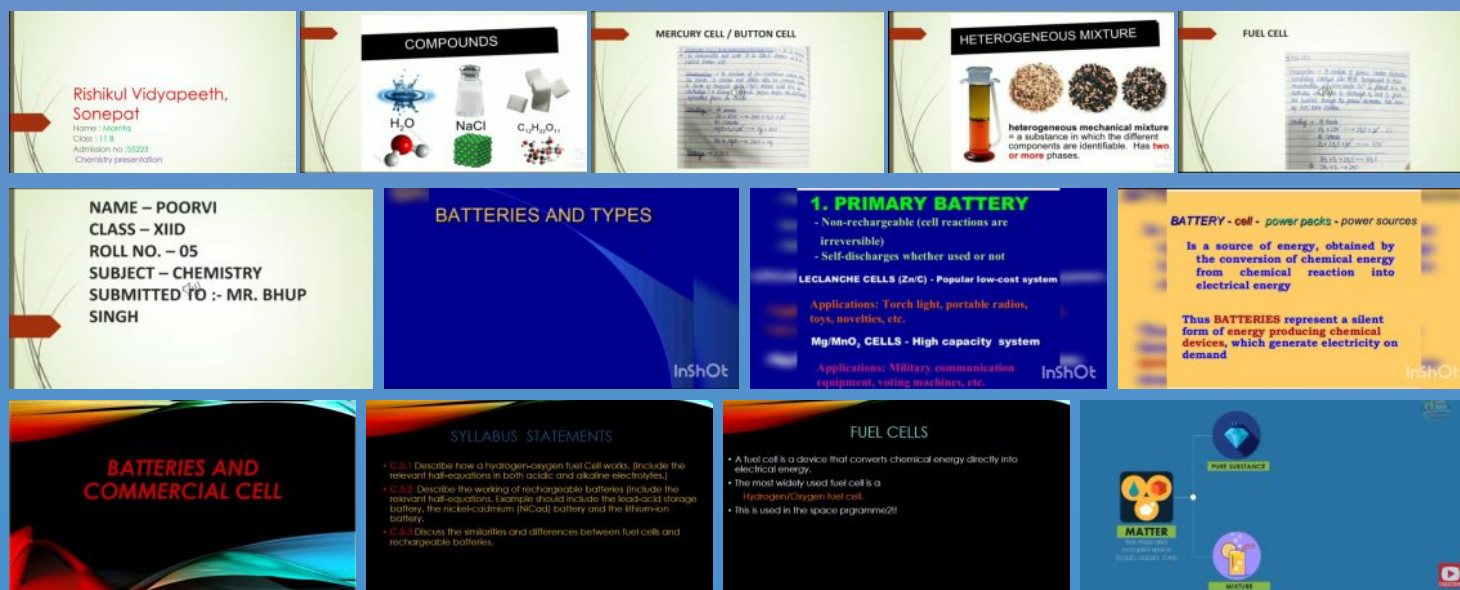
On the basis of origin

Fruits & Flowers

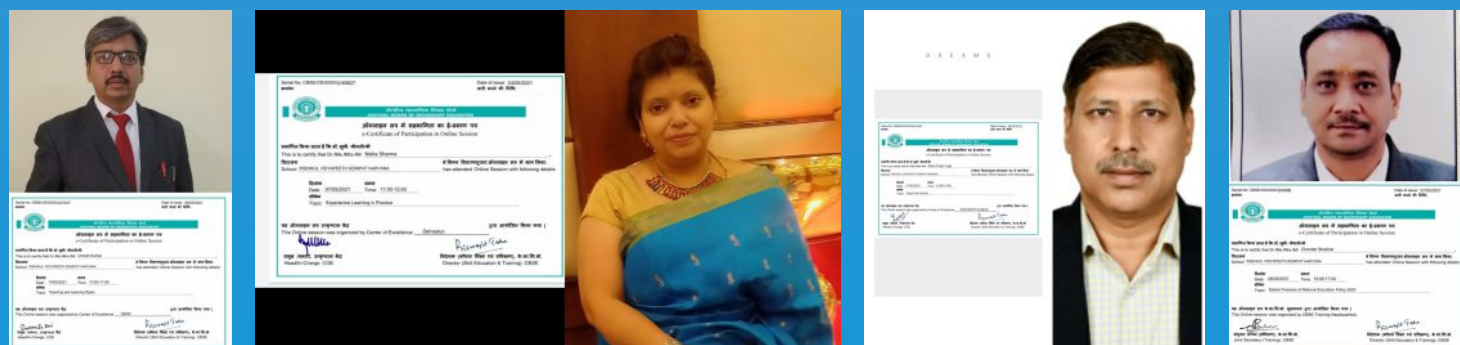

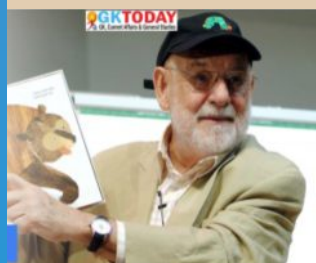
